

Purpose: Provide options for non-hospital provided face and eye protection for personal purchase by staff. These options have been vetted for use following IPC and EH&S guidelines.





Policy:

Stanford Medicine provides all personal protective equipment (PPE) without cost to staff to protect against the hazards of their job. If staff prefer to purchase their own eye protection PPE instead of using what is provided, the following list has been approved. If staff chose to order their own eye protection from this list, **it must be shipped to their home address or other personal location**. It cannot be shipped to the hospital; if it is shipped to the hospital, the shipment will be rejected or the item will be included in hospital inventory.









Staff are required to follow established guidelines for extended use, re-use, and cleaning of eye protection. See [eye protection tip sheet](#) and [PPE FAQs](#) for more information.

List of Approved Face and Eye Protection for Personal Purchase:

These items meet the guidelines set for eye protection; they protect the eyes against splash or spill from the front and sides, are cleanable using our hospital approved disinfectant wipes, and are latex-free. Many options are anti-fog, allowing for better visibility.
