Responders

2 Unit Nurses

PPE

gown + gloves + PAPR

IF

First Responder

Arriving Responder

Cardiopulmonary Arrest

Respiratory Distress

Calls Code 95

Places Surgical Mask on Patient

(If HiOx on: Flow at 15 LPM)

Starts Chest Compressions

Gives Report to Arriving Responder

Calls Code 95

NC at 6 LPM

(if HiOx on: Flow at 15 LPM)

Attaches Cardiac Monitor, Pulse Oximeter, NIBP

Gives Report to Arriving Responder

Receives instruction from Donning/Doffing Officer

Cardiopulmonary Arrest

Respiratory Distress

Brings **Code Cart**

Attaches Defibrillator Pads, AED Mode, Defibrillates if indicated

(If HiOx not on: Stops Chest Compressions, Removes Surgical Mask, Places HiOx at 15 LPM)

Takes over chest compressions

Brings Gray Cart

Attaches Cardiac Monitor, Pulse Oximeter, NIBP

(If HiOx not on: Places HiOx at 15 LPM)

!!! AVOID BVM VENTILATION !!!

(should only be done by an experienced provider with HEPA filter on Ambu Bag)
