First Responder

Arriving Responder

Cardiopulmonary Arrest

Respiratory Distress

Calls Code 95

Places Surgical Mask on Patient

(if HiOx on, flow at 15 LPM)

Starts Chest Compressions

Gives Report to Arriving Responder

Calls Code 95

NC at 6 LPM

(if HiOx on, flow at 15 LPM)

Places Cardiac Monitor, Pulse Oximeter, NIBP

Gives Report to Arriving Responder

Receives instruction from Donning/Doffing Officer

Cardiopulmonary Arrest

Respiratory Distress

Waits for Anesthesiologist for Enhanced PPE

Assists with Intubation

Connects Patient to Ventilator
